Advanced Microsoft Outlook/Exchange Connection for E-mail and Calendar

- LawBase Notes Integration Inside Outlook and Exchange E-mail

Outlook users can click on an icon at the top of their e-mail screen to transfer e-mail content directly into a LawBase Note without ever opening LawBase. Each user has control of their own drop-down list which enables them to scroll and sort names according to their own needs.

- LawBase Synchronization with Outlook Calendar and Wireless Devices

All of the abovementioned LawBase Notes Integration capabilities apply to the Outlook calendar as well. In addition, LawBase can edit calendar entries from any device that is synchronized with Outlook/Exchange such as cell phones, Blackberry or Treo.
